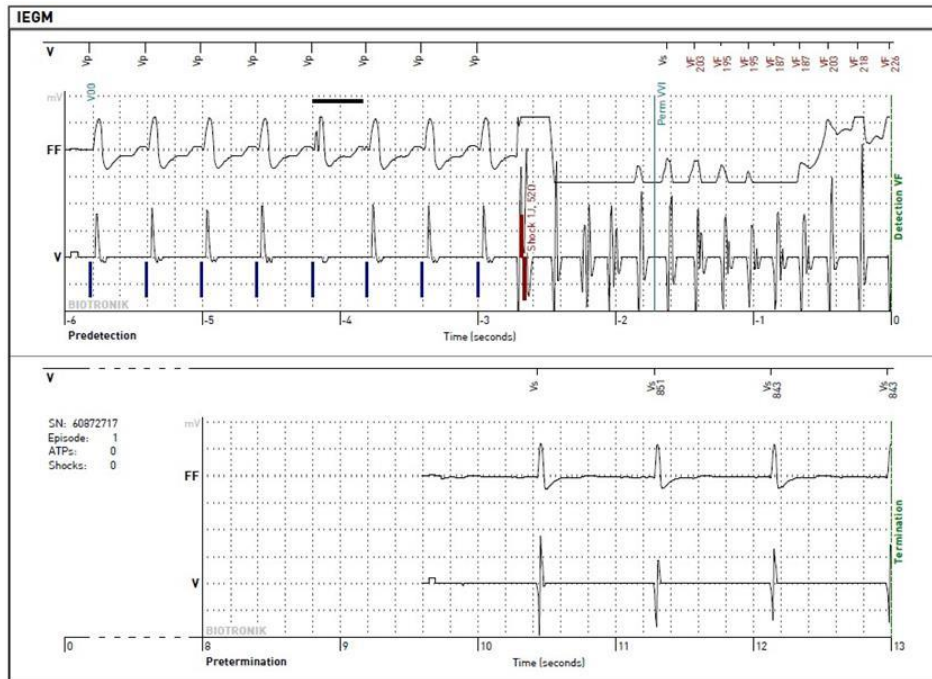


**CARDIAC DEVICE REMOTE MONITORING SPECIALIST (CDRMS) SAMPLE ITEM**
